# Leadership change at NEVEON: Henning Frings to succeed Jürgen Kleinrath as CEO of the foam division

- Jürgen Kleinrath, CEO of NEVEON, is stepping down from his role as division head to pursue a new professional opportunity outside of Greiner.
- Leadership of the foam division will be assumed by Henning Frings, Executive Vice President (EVP) of the NEVEON Business Unit Mobility & Specialties.

**Kremsmünster/Vienna, July 9, 2025** – Jürgen Kleinrath, who has served as CEO of the foam division NEVEON since July 2022 and has been with the company since 2019, will step down from his leadership role and leave the company at his own request. Effective August 1, 2025, Henning Frings, previously Executive Vice President of the NEVEON Business Unit Mobility & Specialties, will take over as head of the division.

Under the leadership of **Jürgen Kleinrath**, NEVEON underwent a period of profound transformation. With entrepreneurial determination, he successfully repositioned and reshaped the division. Key milestones during his tenure as CEO include the consistent focus on core business areas and the successful divestiture of the OEM automotive segment.

Effective August 1, **Henning Frings** will assume the role of CEO. The 37-year-old manager has been with NEVEON since 2020, initially as Director of Corporate Development, and later as General Manager for Aviation & Railway. Most recently, he led the Business Unit Mobility & Specialties as Executive Vice President (EVP). He previously gained international experience at companies such as Amcor Flexibles, Jindal Films, and the Edelmann Group. A father of two, Frings studied in Freiburg and completed an executive MBA program at the University of St. Gallen.
